

344th Military Intelligence Battalion - "Silent Sentinels"

The mission of the 344th Military Intelligence Battalion is to train Soldiers to be Military Intelligence and Cyber professionals. Upon graduation, these Soldiers are tactically and technically competent, disciplined, physically fit, instilled with Army values, and ready to join the Joint Team.

It prepares Soldiers to fight our Nation's wars while taking care of them and their Families. The battalion trains Soldiers in three different Military Occupational Specialties, Military Intelligence, and Cyber. It has more than 70 classes in session at any given time across over 40 blocks of instruction and three separate Companies. The battalion has more than 150 permanent party members with an annual student throughput of about 1,500 Soldiers.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic, special precautions will remain in place in accordance with installation and TRADOC guidance. All Soldiers (to include MOS-T) that arrive at Goodfellow AFB and are not fully-vaccinated against COVID-19 **MUST** be placed into restriction of movement (ROM) status (Quarantine). Soldiers must ensure that they arrive to Goodfellow AFB with enough time to ROM for 7 days and in-process with the 344th MI BN S1 on the following Monday. Failure to do so will result in missing their course start date. Soldiers may not in-process while on ROM status. Soldiers that are fully-vaccinated against COVID-19 are not required to ROM, provided that they maintain a copy of their vaccination card at all times.

ALL TDY SOLDIERS MUST HAVE AN ACTIVE GOVERNMENT CREDIT CARD

Government lodging (the Angelo Inn) is available for all Soldiers in a TDY status. Per diem, meal rates, and related information is available both on the corresponding ATRRS Course page and on the Joint Travel Regulation (JTR). Please consult with your unit's Travel and Finance Officials to ensure that all appropriate travel orders and authorizations are completed prior to arrival to Goodfellow AFB. 344th Military Intelligence Battalion does not provide Travel Orders (DD Form 1610), MFRs, or anything not already-listed on ATRRS for incoming Soldiers. Married Soldiers on Permanent Change of Station (PCS) may bring their Families if their orders authorize it. Those married Soldiers who are authorized to bring their Families may reside in housing on-base. Soldiers should be aware that on-base housing is limited when determining if they should bring their Families. If on-base housing is unavailable, Soldiers are authorized off-base housing.

MOS-T and TDY Soldiers

MOS-Ts and TDY Soldiers arriving to Goodfellow AFB that are not fully-vaccinated against COVID-19 will report directly to the **Angelo Inn, BLDG 3305** across from the Norma Brown Building to initiate ROM. For lodging reservations call the Angelo Inn: DSN 477-3332, commercial (325) 654-3332. Soldiers will then contact **344th MI BN Staff Duty at (325) 654-5295** to report that they have arrived at Goodfellow and have initiated their ROM.

Soldiers on ROM on Goodfellow AFB are restricted to Goodfellow AFB and their assigned room, the Commissary, Laundry room and DFAC until completion of their ROM. Once ROM is completed the Soldiers will take guidance on further base restrictions from their respective command teams.

It is recommended that any Soldier traveling to Goodfellow AFB such as MOS-T's or TDY status plan to arrive 14 days prior to their scheduled class date in order to facilitate the ROM and in-processing timeline requirements. If any Soldier is unable to arrive with enough time to ROM for 7 days, in-process the following Monday, and begin their scheduled class date after

in-processing, they will be placed on hold-under status until another class date becomes available.

35N Soldiers (USAR/ARNG/RA) attend a 26 week course. IAW the JTR, this course is a Permanent Change of Station move to Goodfellow AFB. Soldiers authorized to bring Family members may ship household goods. Soldiers authorized to live off post will receive the Goodfellow AFB BAH rates. Soldiers who choose not to bring their Families may submit a waiver request to DA G1 Entitlements Branch based on short term PCS for professional military schooling.

35P Soldiers (USAR/ARNG/RA) attending Arabic, Chinese, Korean, Spanish, Persian-Farsi, Pashtu or Non-Target languages can expect to remain at Goodfellow AFB from 5 to 14 weeks depending on language. IET Soldiers arriving from Basic Combat Training (language bypass) will be on Permanent Change of Station status and will be assigned to the barracks. IET Soldiers from the Defense Language Institute and MOS-Ts will be on TDY status.

35S Soldiers (USAR/ARNG/RA) attend a 14 week course. IAW the JTR, this course is not a Permanent Change of Station move to Goodfellow AFB. Soldiers are not authorized to bring Family members, and may not ship household goods.
