# Key Spouse Program

- Squadron Key Spouses provide resources and support to military members and families.
- The Key Spouse program is a Command sponsored program.
- Key Spouses are volunteers appointed by the Commander and trained through the Airman & Family Readiness Center (AFRC).
- They follow Privacy Act, confidentiality, and mandatory reporting guidelines.

# Key Spouse Mission

- Welcome new families to the squadron and answer any questions about base and community resources
- Exchange vital information between unit leadership and families
- Provide a peer-to-peer support system for handling military life experiences
- Share squadron and base events, community information, volunteer opportunities, and referral services
- Help families prepare for separations due to deployments or long-term TDYs

# Military Dependents

- PLEASE ensure dependents are registered in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) to be eligible for TRICARE and ID cards
- PLEASE ensure Servicemember Group Life Insurance (SGLI) is up to date and includes your dependents
  - If an emergency arises the last thing you want your family to think about is insurance
- Get an emergency contact number in case your family needs to get a hold of you
- Ensure your dependents are on your future PCS orders
- Any questions contact your MTL or Flight leadership
